






About Edo

Edo was the former name of Japan's capital city Tokyo during the Edo period 1603-1867

As the center of politics and economics, Edo had become a sprawling



metropolis, reaching a population of more than 1,000,000 people surpassing that of Paris and London at the beginning of the 18th century.

Edo was renamed Tokyo in 1868 the 4th year of the Keiō period under the Meiji Restoration.


